History AutoCAD began as Carinci Studio, a program designed to produce architectural drawings. In the late 1970s, 3D graphics were fast and affordable enough that offices and homes could be digitally illustrated in three dimensions. In the early 1980s, the use of CAD programs to design and create shop drawings for automakers expanded, as did demand for CAD programs for architects and other professionals. At first, CAD programs were used by engineers, architects, and designers as a "computer-assisted design" (CAD) or "computer-aided drafting" (CAD/CAM) tool, but by the mid-1980s, businesses started using CAD for design, engineering, and manufacturing. Autodesk, the creator of AutoCAD, published an addendum in 1983, when AutoCAD 1.0 was introduced. AutoCAD was the first CAD program for the PC. Before its release, most CAD programs ran on mainframe computers or minicomputers, with each CAD operator (user) working at a separate graphics terminal. AutoCAD was designed to work on the personal computer, and the first major release of the program included a graphics controller built into the Apple II's graphics adapter card. The first batch of Apple II's shipped with AutoCAD, which was a key factor in its success. AutoCAD was one of the first computer programs to feature a graphical user interface (GUI). AutoCAD was originally developed by Carinci Studio. The first version was released in 1982. In 1983, the first major release of AutoCAD, called AutoCAD 1.0, was introduced. Version 1.0 of the software was released as a bundle of PC software, a Mac application, and a printer driver. Autodesk was founded in 1982 and started development on AutoCAD. The first version of AutoCAD 1.0 was released to manufacturing companies. The initial sales pitch for AutoCAD was "for the average graphics person, and for the average computer person." Although the software was designed as a simple drafting package for home use, it was also designed to be used by engineers, architects, and other professionals. History AutoCAD was originally developed in the late 1980s by a company called Vertecs, which was later bought by Autodesk. The user interface was a closed console interface at the time, based on the Macintosh, which was in contrast with the PC-based interfaces popular at that time. In the early 1990s, the Autodesk management decided to release AutoCAD on Microsoft Windows as a PC application, with the intention of driving the Mac version to a niche market. This led to the development of the very different approach to CAD on the PC. The first version of AutoCAD, version 2.1, was released on March 15, 1992. As it was launched after the CAD market had developed significantly from the original IBM CAD on the IBM PC, AutoCAD was well received by the design industry, but with the introduction of the version 2.2 it became the de facto standard. In 1997, AutoCAD 3D was released and the widely praised add-ons, CADBook and VectorWorks were introduced. In 1993, Autodesk released AutoCAD for the HP Prime Workstation, which included a window-based interface like the original Macintosh one and was also the first CAD application to include a Windows platform. The HP version was launched after Autodesk purchased the rights to AutoCAD from Vinn Corporation, and was offered to all of Vinn's clients. AutoCAD for HP Prime Workstation was the first CAD application to include a Windows platform and all future Autodesk products would be on a Windows-based platform. In 1994, after a lawsuit from Autodesk, Autodesk released the Windows version of the original software for personal computers. Both the Windows and Macintosh versions were given the AutoCAD logo. In 1995, Autodesk launched AutoCAD LT, which was initially only available for Mac but soon introduced the same Windows version. In 1996, Autodesk released AutoCAD Architecture, which provided a significant number of tools for architects and interior designers. In 1998, Autodesk introduced the first version of AutoCAD for Windows NT, offering improved functionality for technical drawings. In 1999, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2000, the first version of AutoCAD to be compatible with Windows NT 4.0. a1d647c40b
